In 2022, Walkersville, MD had a population of 6.24k people with a median age of 44.1 and a median household income of \$138,190. Between 2021 and 2022 the population of Walkersville, MD grew from 6,134 to 6,239, a 1.71% increase and its median household income grew from \$114,340 to \$138,190, a 20.9% increase.

The 5 largest ethnic groups in Walkersville, MD are White (Non-Hispanic) (81.6%), Black or African American (Non-Hispanic) (5.88%), Two+ (Hispanic) (4.07%), Two+ (Non-Hispanic) (3.81%), and Asian (Non-Hispanic) (3.37%).

## Walkersville Information



#### **Snow**

- Residents are required to clear their sidewalks of snow and ice within twenty-four (24) hours after precipitation has ceased falling.
- It is unlawful to shovel, blow, or place any snow into the street.
- Parking on town streets is prohibited when there is an accumulation of snow/ice of four (4) or more inches.
- In the event of snow, please remove your car from the street promptly to accommodate the snowplows.

#### **Sidewalks**

- Maintenance of sidewalks and curbs is the responsibility of the homeowner. The homeowner is required to clear the sidewalk of snow.
- If your property has a fire hydrant, please clear it of snow for use by the fire department and everyone's safety.





#### **Mowing**


 It is unlawful to allow grass, brush, or weeds to grow over 8" (eight inches) on any part of your property.

## Walkersville Information



- Food Bank: Operates in the basement of the Town Hall (21 West Frederick Street, Walkersville, MD) on Mondays 6:30 7:30 p.m. and Thursdays 1:00 3:00 p.m. You may bring non-perishable food donations during regular Town Hall hours 8:30 a.m. 4:30 p.m. M-F or place them 24/7 in the food donation box located alongside the building in the entrance driveway. Food Bank phone number/answering machine 301-845-4229.
- Town Meetings: Held each month on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays; in the months of July, November, and December, meetings are only on the 2nd Wednesday.
- Curbside Recycling: Provided by Frederick County on <u>Blue Mondays</u>.
- Bulk Recycling: Every 2nd and 4th Wednesday a recycling dumpster is available in the Town Hall parking lot, 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., for Frederick County residents to drop off their household recycling.
- Bulk Trash Pickup: Sponsored by the Town of Walkersville twice each year, June 8 and November 9, 2024. Place your bulk trash at the curb after the regular Wednesday trash pick-up.
- Walkersville Day: The 3rd Saturday in May.
   Yard sales and food opportunities throughout
   the Town. \*Note: The Town does NOT sponsor
   this event. It is up to the
   business/homeowner/church if they choose to
   participate.\*
- Walkersville Firemen's CarnivalL The dates, prices, and food schedule are posted on the Walkersville Volunteer Fire Department's <u>home</u> <u>page</u>.
- Trick or Treat: The Town neither sanctions nor sets the time for Trick or Treat. Each neighborhood or HOA may schedule its own activities.
